MARCOS USES ANIMATIONS WHICH DEVELOP IN REAL TIME REACTING TO SOUND, MERGED WITH LIVE IMAGES CAPTURED WITH 2 FIREWIRE CAMERAS AND POST-PRODUCED ON THE SPOT, INTEGRATING THEM AS ANOTHER SOURCE. THE 2 CAMERAS SHOW DETAILS OF GREGORIO'S AND IVOR'S WORK. HE ALSO USES SHORT FILMS RECORDED FOR THE OCCASION WITH THE AIM OF CONFUSING SPECTATORS BY SHOWING FALSE AND REAL LIVE CAMERAS. 3072 X 768

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IVOR PLAYS A SAMPLER WITH ENABLED SCRIPTS ON THE COMPUTER THROUGH A CONTROLLER KEYBOARD, PROCESSING THE SOUND LIVE.

TOGETHER THEY CARRY OUT AN AUDIO VISUAL SET BASED ON IMPROVISATION SEEKING THE GREATEST POSSIBLE INTEGRATION BETWEEN SOUND AND VISION.

Graphic designer and photographer, he has worked in several design agencies both in Buenos Aires and Madrid.
